We are a full service campground and rental facility available year round for your group, church or family to reserve for private retreats and events.

### LODGING

We have a wide range of unique sleeping options to accommodate your group and it's needs.

Whether you have a small group of 25 or a group with over 150+ participants, we are ready for you!

#### the lodges

Inspired by hospitality and comfort, both of the lodges are equipped with full bedding and bath towels.

**The Lodge** is an 8 room (32 beds / 40 person) home that has a large meeting space that can hold 75 and and a common room on the second floor that can be used as a breakout or game space. Click <u>HERE</u> to see photos and layout of the South Lodge.

**The North Lodge** is a 7 bedroom (31 bed / 40 person), 5 bathroom home including a full kitchen, living room, and meeting space that can hold 40.

#### the dorms

Functionality coupled with fellowship, the dorms are for groups to stay economically. Campers must bring own bedding, pillows, and towels.

**The Lower Dorm** consists of five rooms with a total of 62 beds and two multi stall bathrooms with showers. The common area provides opportunity to be used as a meeting room that can hold 75 people. Has a ping pong table.

#### cabins

Secluded but centrally located, our cabins are a great place to put up a guest speaker or family. They can sleep up to 4 people and includes all bedding and bath towels. - Includes 1 queen bed, 1 day bed, and 1 trundle. Click <u>HERE</u> to see photos of the cabins.

#### camping

**Tent Camping.** Bring your own tents for an authentic camping experience with complete access to the rest of camp. Includes access to bathrooms, showers, and a camp meeting space.

**RV/Trailer Camping.** Want to bring your own RV or trailer to camp? Great! We have a handful of spots that include all hookups (electric, water, sewage).

With over 500 acres of rolling Central Coast land, we have fun and engaging opportunities for you to *experience life* around every corner at Granite Ridge.

#### included activities

Trails. Hike or use our complementary mountain-bikes to explore our six miles of professionally prepared trails.
Pool and Pond. Cool off with canoes, corcls, kayaks, slackline, catch and release fishing, climbing wall and water basketball.
Games and Sports. Horse Shoes, Gaga Pit, Ladder Ball, Ping Pong, Vertical-4-Square, Basketball, Football, Volleyball.
Campfire. Stay warm, tell stories, and build memories.

#### additional activities

Involving staff-assistance, these activities need 10 people minimum to participate in. Activities generally last 1 hour. Prices are additional and per person.

**Axe and Hatchet Throwing** (\$5): Test your skills by throwing sharp pieces of flying metal into wood targets!

Laser Tag (\$5): Night activity to get everyone moving.

**Archery Tag** (\$10): Get a chance to shoot your fellow campers or team leader in this fast-paced game.

**Shooting Range** (\$20-\$25): Feel comfortable and safe with a certified Range Safety Officer to guide you through basic target-shooting.



### **MEETING SPACES**

These are places where wisdom is passed down, minds are formed, and lives are changed. A meeting space is included in your reservation and we will do out

best to accommodate any preferences. They include:

- Access to WiFi (\$4/day, 3 devices per person)

- Basic A/V Setup (2 speakers, 1 mic, 1 soundboard)

#### spaces

**The Outdoor Chapel** is a scenic, isolated space that seats 125 people It is a great place for morning or evening sessions in the warmer months.

**The Lodge Conference Room** can seat 65 people in stadium seating, or 30 people with a conference setup. It has a large flat screen TV that can be used for PowerPoints or videos.

**The Lodge Upper Room** is located on the second floor of The Lodge and can be used as a small group breakout area, or meeting space that can hold 35 people.

**The Amphitheater** is a camp tradition where your group can sing songs, tell stories, and bond around the campfire. It does not have access to electrical and is best used in the mornings and evenings.

**The Lower Dorm Conference Room** seats 65 people maximum in stadium seating. It can also be used for a game or craft area.

**The Barn** is a great indoor meeting space for larger groups. It can fit 100 people in stadium seating or 60 people in conference setup. It is equipped with a stage and full A/V hookups.

**The Upper Dorm Atrium** seats 65 people maximum in stadium seating. It can also be used for a game or craft area.

**The North Lodge Great Room** can seat 40 people in stadium seating or 20 in conference setup. A comfortable and functional hangout or meeting space.





### FOOD



At Granite Ridge, one thing that we know we can hang our hat on is our home-cooked food. With a kitchen motto like "camp-calories don't count", no one is going hungry here!

#### accomodating meals

Our chef has over 15 years of experience cooking at camp, and it shows!

We accommodate for dietary needs and preferences by deconstructing meals and obtaining allergy information beforehand to tailor a menu to a particular group when possible. This is why we require all groups to register individually two weeks before their arrival date. Every meal is labeled and will have multiple options. As there may be multiple groups dining, we prepare a nutritional menu for all campers and their dietary needs using seasonal ingredients.

#### hospitality

Open 24/7, our Dining Hall is always available for a hot cup of tea, cold glass of water, or a midnight cereal snack.

#### other fees

**Day use** is provided when your group wants to experience Granite Ridge for a single day, with no overnight accommodations, this price includes two meals.

\$60.00 per person Min. to reserve = 20 Exclusive use = 200 \$30 for  $\frac{1}{2}$  day (1 meal)

A **la carte meals** are for groups staying for an extra meal or coming for a meal only (any usage of the grounds or participation in group activities will be charged a day or ½ day use).

\$15 breakfast \$20 lunch \$25 dinner

**Children** are welcome! Ages 0-2 are free; Ages 3-7 are ½ price.
